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Materials needed: - Number 20 thread (ballerinas measure 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "), two size 10 seed beads 2 shuttles.

Skills Required:- Knowledge of SCMR, Split rings, Josephine Knot.

Version 1 – facing front

Add two beads to the thread and wind 3 yards of thread onto Sh1. Pull off another 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards , cut and wind onto the second shuttle - CTM. Before starting be sure that the beads are on the Sh1 thread.

Head – Sh1 in right hand to start

JK: 2 + (Vlp on SCMR) 8 Vlp (5mm) 2 Cl SS





Version 2 – facing sideways

2 shuttles. Add 1 seed bead to the thread and wind 3 yards of thread onto Sh1. Pull off another 3 yards and wind onto the second shuttle - CTM. Before starting be sure that the bead is on the Sh1 thread. Note - follow fig. 2 for body and skirt then fig 5 for arms and legs.

Head – (Sh1 in right hand to start).


