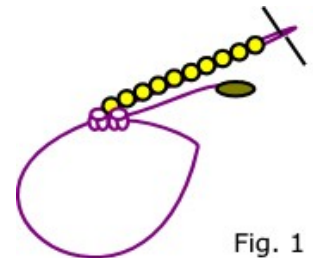


[HOME](#) Adding Beads to Centre of Long Beaded Picot © Jane Eborall 2008

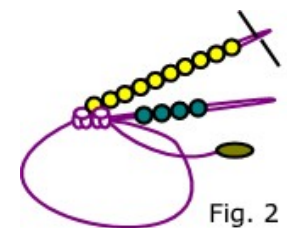


To make these beaded picots you will need to use [this method of adding bead](#) to a very long picot.

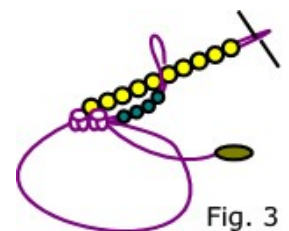
1. Work 1 ds and add 10 beads to thread at back of hand (LBP) - holding in place with a safety pin or paperclip. Close to hold the paperclip.



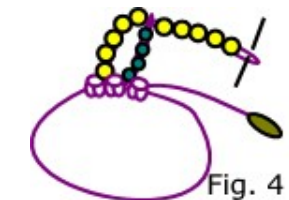
2. Work 1 d. Add a further 4 beads to thread at back of hand (LBP) - do **not** add a holding pin.



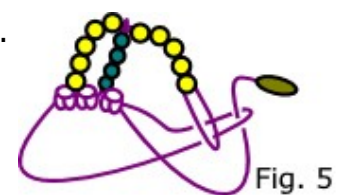
3. Now take the first LBP through the loop at the end of the second LBP and move it along to lie in between the 5th and 6th bead.



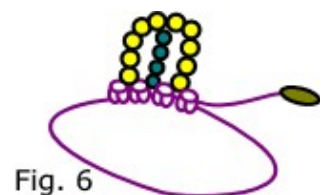
4. Tighten the second LBP and work a further ds.



5. Remove the safety pin from the first LBP and join back onto the ring.



6. Work a further ds. To complete the flower repeat from the beginning four times. There should only be one ds between each petal.
