I designed this bell as a small Christmas Tree decoration or (if worked in a fine thread) as a motif to be added to a wedding / wedding anniversary card. It can also be used to make earrings. The bell is made in one 'round'.





+B add bead to picot before joining vsp very small picot

Add 2 small beads, then 1 large bead to Wsh2 before starting. 17 further small beads will be needed for adding to picots before joining. This motif is worked in one round. Start with **Wsh1**





R10: 2 +B (R9) 1 +B (SR2) 4

Ch: 8

R11: 3 + B(R1) 3

Ch: 9-3+B LJ (R1) Change to **Wsh2**

R12: 3 +B (p on last chain) 3 - 3 - 3 Change to **Wsh1**

Ch: $3 + B (3^{rd} p R12) 9$

R13: 3 +B (R1) 3

Ch: 8

R14: 4 +B (SR2) 1 - 2 R15: 2 +B (R14) 2 - 4

Charles C

SR16: 3 +B (R15) 3 +B (SR3) 6 - 4 - 1 / 4
