

Regular Bow - © Jane Eborall



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This is a simple, split ring only bow which requires no hiding ends or sewing in. It could easily be adapted to make smaller or larger bows.

Abbreviations

Sh1	working shuttle 1 (purple)	Sh2	working shuttle 2 (green)		
+ B	add bead to picot before joining	Btwn	between	Lp	long picot
SR	split ring	Cl	close		

Before starting, add 5 beads to Sh2. A further 4 beads are needed for adding to picots before joining. Leave two ends when starting the first SR.

- SR1 – SR5: 6 / 6 Cl
 - SR6: 4 / 4 – 4 Lp (move 5 beads onto picot with small spaces btwn beads for further joins) 4 Cl
 - SR7: 4 / 4 + (Lp SR6 btwn last 2 beads) 4 – 4 Cl
 - SR8: 6 / 5 Cl
 - SR9: 7 / 6 Cl
 - SR10: 8 / 7 Cl
 - SR11: 9 / 8 Cl
 - SR12: 10 / 9 Cl
 - SR13: 9 / 8 Cl
 - SR14: 8 / 7 Cl
 - SR15: 7 / 6 Cl
 - SR16: 6 / 5 Cl
 - SR17: 4 – 4 / 4 + B (SR7) 4 + (Lp SR6 btwn next 2 beads) 4 Cl
 - SR18: 4 + B (SR17) 4 / 4 – 4 Cl Repeat SR8 – SR16
 - SR28: 4 / 4 + B(SR18) 4 + (Lp SR6 btwn next 2 beads) 4 Cl
 - SR29: 4 / 4 + (Lp SR6 btwn next 2 beads) 4 + B (SR6) 4 Cl
 - Repeat SR1 – SR5 finishing with SR34
 - Cut ends

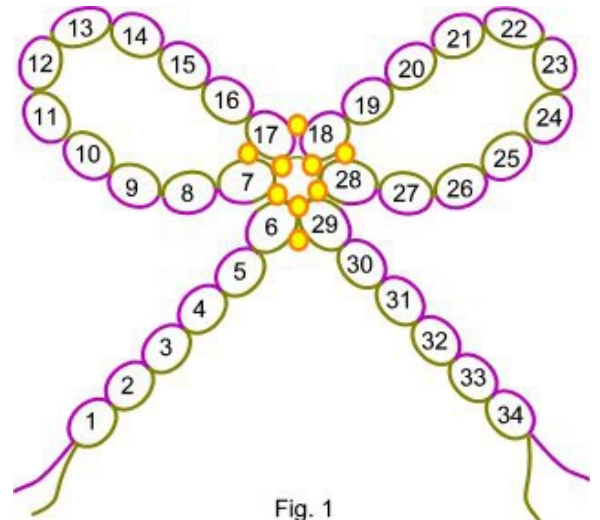
