# Bracelet # 1 - © Jane Eborall - 2000



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#### **Materials Required**

Two contrasting colours in no. 20 thread, centre button with two holes running through, fastening (this can be a small button), small beads (approx.60).

NB - On the first row always bring the shuttle and chain UNDER the previous chain before joining the new ring to previous ring. On the second row, bring the chain OVER the previous one before joining - see fig. 3

Ch

SLT

#### Abbreviations

R	ring
+B	add a bead to p before joining
C & T	close and tie

Shoe lace trick (tie a knot!)

chain

#### Instructions

#### First half, first side (figs. 1 & 4) - colour A

2 make a very long p and take it through the lower hole in the R: large button (use a safety pin to hold this picot in place until the second half is made) 2 - 2 - 2 Ch: 10 \*Using colour B 2 + B (last p of previous R) 2 - 2 - 2R: Ch: 10 Using colour A and bringing the ring and chain under the last chain 2 + B (last p of previous R) 2 - 2 - 2R: Ch: 10 Repeat from \* for the length required (T & C the previous ring and chain) and continue with one colour only adding the fastening (a button with a shank will enable the bracelet to be adjustable) as follows. Ch: 4 + (last p of previous R) 2 make a picot and take it

through the fastening and then take shuttle thread through the loop thus made. See fig. 2. Continue chain 2 SLT p SLT 4

## First half, second side (fig. 3)


As first but adding a bead to the opposite p on first side and remembering to bring the chains OVER the previous ones to correspond to first side. When working the final ring of this side take the last p through the fancy button and again hold it on a safety pin until the second half is made.


## Second half, first side (fig. 1) - colour A

2 + (corresponding picot taken through the fancy bead) 2 - 2 - 2R: 10 Ch: \*Using colour B 2 + B (last p of previous R) 2 - 2 - 2R: Ch: 10

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Using colour A and bringing the ring and chain under the last chain

R: 2 +B (last p of previous R) 2 - 2 - 2

Ch: 10

Repeat from \* for the length required.

Either add the second part of the fastening as first half of bracelet or

Ch: 4 + (last p of previous R) 2 4 SLT p SLT 4

## First half, second side (fig. 3)

As first but adding a bead to the opposite p on first side and remembering to bring the chains OVER the previous ones to correspond to first side. When working the final ring of this side join the last p to the corresponding p taken through the fancy button. T & C
