Version 1 – no beads on button



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Version 1 beads on button



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Version 2 rings on chains

Skills required – knowledge of split rings and using beads.

NOTE When joining to the button, pull a loop of thread **UP** through the appropriate buttonhole and add four seed beads to this loop/picot. Take shuttle and thread through the loop after the beads and snug up the join. Continue with ring. [This link may help too.](#)

Also for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics* and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

Abbreviations

Sh1 Shuttle 1

DNRW Do not reverse work

Cl close

T & C Tie and cut

vsp Very small picot

+ join

BBBB Four beads added to thread coming through button.

+ B Add bead or beads to picot before joining.

Sh2 Shuttle 2

B bead moved into place on shuttle

RW Reverse work

RoCh Ring on chain

SS Switch shuttles

+ B Add bead to picot before joining

For clarity – no beads have been shown on the picots pulled through the buttonholes.

Version 1

Materials required.

No. 20 thread and 2 shuttles. Size 11 seed beads, ½" four or two hole button. Instructions are given for a four hole button but a two hole one will need six joins in one hole and six in the other. You will need 3¼ yards on Sh1 and 2¼ yards on Sh2.

Before starting add 6 beads to Sh1 and 30 to Sh2. A further six beads are required for joining picots.

R1: 3 vsp 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl DNRW

SR2: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 BBB MB 6 RW

SR3: 4 + B (SR2) 4 / 4 B 4 Cl DNRW

R4: 3 + (vsp R1) 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl RW

Ch: 4 RW

R5: 3 + (vsp R4) 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl

DNRW

SR6: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 BBB MB 6 RW

SR7: 4 + B (SR6) 4 / 4 B 4 Cl DNRW

R8: 3 + (vsp R5) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl RW

Ch: 4 RW

R9: 3 + (vsp R8) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl

DNRW

SR10: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 BBB MB 6 RW

SR11: 4 + B (SR10) 4 / 4 B 4 Cl DNRW

R12: 3 + (vsp R9) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 Cl RW

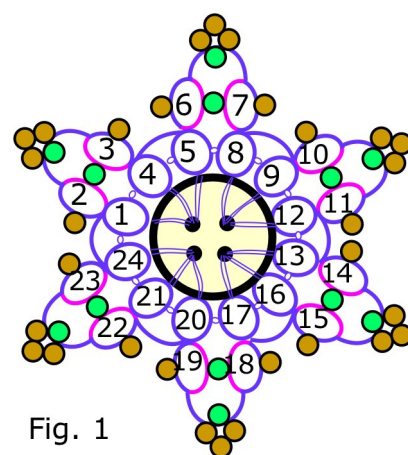

SR22: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 CI RW

Ch: 6 BBB MB 6 RW

SR23: 4 + B (SR22) 4 / 4 B 4 CI DNRW

R24: 3 + (vsp R22) 2 + (4th hole in button) + BBBB 2 + (vsp R1) 3 CI RW

Ch: 4 T & C base R1

Version 2

Materials required

No. 20 thread and 2 shuttles. Size 11 beads and ½" four or two hole button. Instructions are given for a four hole button but a two hole one will need six joins in one hole and six in the other.

You will need 4¼ yards on Sh1 and 2¼ yards on Sh2.

Before starting add 30 beads to Sh2. A further 6 beads are required for joining picots.

R1: 3 vsp 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI

DNRW

SR2: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 CI RW

Ch: 5 vsp 1 SS 3 beads at back of hand

RoCh3: 1 + (vsp Ch) 3 B 3 B 3 B 3 vsp 1 CI SS

Ch: 1 + (vsp RoCh) 5 RW

SR4: 4 + B (SR2) 4 / 4 B 4 CI DNRW

R5: 3 + (vsp R1) 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI RW

Ch: 4 RW

R6: 3 + (vsp R5) 2 + (1st hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI DNRW

SR7: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 CI RW

Ch: 5 vsp 1 SS 3 beads at back of hand

RoCh8: 1 + (vsp Ch) 3 B 3 B 3 B 3 vsp 1 CI SS

Ch: 1 + (vsp RoCh) 5 RW

SR9: 4 + B (SR7) 4 / 4 B 4 CI DNRW

R10: 3 + (vsp R6) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI RW

Ch: 4 RW

R11: 3 + (vsp R10) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI DNRW

SR12: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 CI RW

Ch: 5 vsp 1 SS 3 beads at back of hand

RoCh13: 1 + (vsp Ch) 3 B 3 B 3 B 3 vsp 1 CI SS

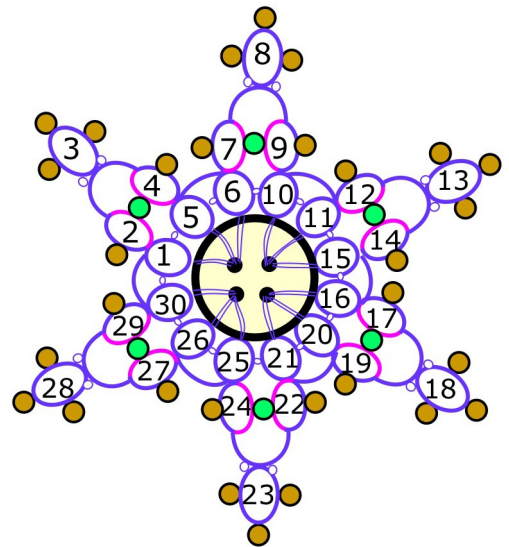

SR14: 4 + B (SR12) 4 / 4 B 4 CI DNRW

R15: 3 + (vsp R11) 2 + (2nd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI RW

Ch: 4 RW

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R16: 3 + (vsp R15) 2 + (3rd hole in button) + BBBB 2 vsp 3 CI DNRW
 SR17: 4 – 4 / 4 B 4 CI RW
Ch: 5 vsp 1 SS 3 beads at back of hand
RoCh18: 1 + (vsp Ch) 3 B 3 B 3 B 3 vsp 1 CI SS
Ch: 1 + (vsp RoCh) 5 RW
