

[HOME](#) Snickerdoodle Earring © Jane Eborall – amended 2012



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Materials required – 1 shuttle, number 20 thread and beads (size 11 seed beads plus slightly larger ones size 9 – some experimentation may be required)

Skills required -

Abbreviations

R	ring	LBP	Long beaded picot
seta	4 first half ds	setb	4 second half ds
B	bead	Cl	close
T & C	Tie and cut		

Wind shuttle with 1½ yards of thread and add 8 beads in the size and order shown below.

The A beads will appear in the centre of the rings and should be roughly size 9.

The B beads will appear in between the rings at the centre of the earring and should be size 11 (seed beads).

Load beads onto the shuttle in this order B, A, B, A, B, A, B, A.

Tip – [see this link](#) for adding beads to long picots (long beaded picots).

Move B to back of hand before starting.

R1: 4 – 4 LBP (5 beads size 11) 1 seta B (from back of hand) setb 1 + (LBP) 4 – 4 Cl

Move B to base of R1 before starting R2. Also move next B to back of hand before starting R2.

R2: 4 + B (R1) 4 LBP (9 beads size 11) 1 seta B (from back of hand) setb 1 + (LBP moving split ring finding onto the LBP before joining) 4 – 4 Cl

Move B to base of R2 before starting R3. Also move next B to back of hand before starting R3.

R3: 4 + B (R2) 4 LBP (5 beads size 11) 1 seta B (from back of hand) setb 1 + (LBP) 4 – 4 Cl

Move B to base of R3 before starting R4. Also move next B to back of hand before starting R4.

R4: 4 + B (R3) 4 LBP (use a variety of beads in different sizes) 1 seta B setb 1 + (LBP) 4 + B (1st
