Using 2 shuttles with same colour on both, add 6 beads to Sh1 & 42 to Sh2

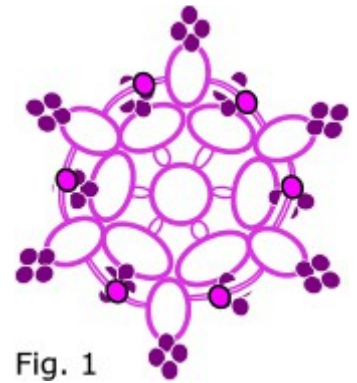
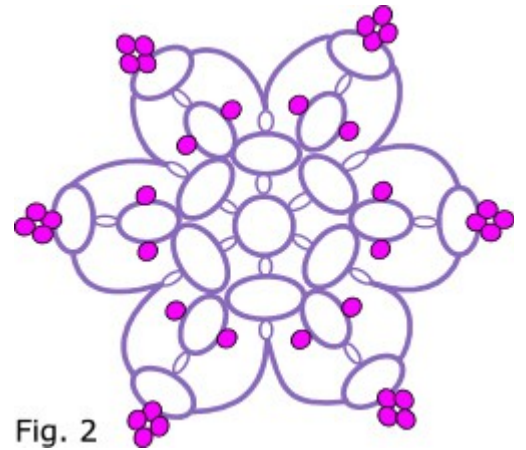

**To make the braid for the ring [please visit this page](#).**

When you start leave ends of approximately 4" - 5". When you have completed the length needed (which will be the size of the finger the ring is going to fit), you can work round the piece with a row of chains (3 ds) or chains with tiny picots. As this gives a very firm finish it will not stretch. Leave ends of 4" - 5".

Take the braid ends up through the outer ring, through the inner ring and then through a large bead. Take two ends through a small bead, back through the large bead and the two ring pieces tying behind the main ring. Do the same with the other two ends. For further help, [please email me](#).
