## **Centre of flower**

Using 2 shuttles with same colour on both, add 6 beads to Sh1 & 42 to Sh2

## **Centre Ring**

CR: 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 Cl DNRW

#### Round 1

1 bead @ back of hand before starting

SR1: Fp 2 / Fp 2 vsp 2  $^{BBB}_{B}$  2 Cl Rw SS 3 B's @ back of hand

before starting

R2:  $_{\text{L}}$  2 - 2  $_{\text{BBB}}$  2 - 2 Cl Rw SS B @ back of hand before

starting

SR3:  $2 + (\text{next vsp on CR}) 2 / 2^{\text{BBB}} 2 \text{ Cl Rw SS 3 B's @ back}$ 

of hand before starting

R4: 2 + B (last p previous RING)  $2^{BBB}B 2 - 2 CI Rw SS$  Repeat from \* 3 times 1 B @ back of hand before starting

SR11: 2 + (next vsp on CR) 2 + (vsp SR1) /  $2^{BBB}$  2 Cl Rw SS

3 B's @ back of hand before starting

R12: 2 + B (last p previous RING)  $2^{BBB}_{B} 2 + B$  (p R2) 2 Cl T & C

#### Outer part of flower

Using 2 shuttles with same colour on both, add 6 beads to Sh1 & 30 to Sh2

### **Centre Ring**

CR: 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 vsp 2 Cl DNRW

#### Round 1

SR1: Fp 2 / Fp 2 vsp 2 - 2 Cl Rw SS 2 B's @ back of hand before starting

R2: 2 B 2 - 2 B 2 Cl Rw SS

\*SR3: 2 + (next vsp on CR) 2 / 2 - 2 Cl Rw SS 2 B's @ back of hand before starting

R4: 2 B 2 - 2 B 2 Cl Rw SS

Repeat from \* 3 times

SR11: 2 + (next vsp on CR) 2 + (vsp SR1) / 2 - 2 Cl Rw SS 1 B @ back of hand before starting


SR12: 2 B 2 / 2 B 2 CI DNRW

Continue to next round

Round 2 3 B's @ back of hand before starting


SR13: Fp 2 vsp 2 BBB 2 / Fp 2 CI DNRW SS

Ch: \*6 Lj + B (next SR round 1) 6 Rw 1 B's @ back of hand before starting



SR14: 2 (next R round 1) 2 / 2  $^{\rm BBB}{}_{\rm B}$  2 Cl Rw repeat from \* 4 times

Ch: 6 Lj + B (next SR round 1) 6 + (vsp SR13) T & C



## To make the braid for the ring please visit this page.

When you start leave ends of approximately 4" - 5". When you have completed the length needed (which will be the size of the finger the ring is going to fit), you can work round the piece with a row of chains (3 ds) or chains with tiny picots. As this gives a very firm finish it will not stretch. Leave ends of 4" - 5".

Take the braid ends up through the outer ring, through the inner ring and then through a large bead. Take two ends through a small bead, back through the large bead and the two ring pieces tying behind the main ring. Do the same with the other two ends. For further help, please email me.
