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Originally designed for my friend Connie this little fish was intended as an earring but can be used as 'just a fish'!

Skills required: Knowledge of split rings and <u>down picot</u> with a bead – see abbreviations. **Materials:** 3 shuttles – 2 with same colour 1 with contrast. 1 small bead for eye on Sh1. Earring findings.

22 beads are needed to add to very long picots for each fish.




