February 1927 Needlecraft Magazine Tatting Combined with Rickrack and Novelty Braids Anna J. Johnson Adapted by Regina A. Brummett

mp = mock picot rr = rickrack + join

#5 Rose Medallion

Seam a length of rickrack together so that there are 12 points

R 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 , clr, mp (mock picot)

Ch 6 + next p, repeat around, joining last ch into mp

Ch 8 + between chains, repeat around

Ch 10 + between chains, repeat around

Ch 4, + to point of rr, 4 – 4 + next point of rr, 4 + between chains; repeat around, joining last ch where 1^{st} started. End off and hide ends.

Outer edge: R 5-5+ outer point of rr, 5-5, clr, rw *Ch 5-5, rw R 5+p prev r, 5-5, clr, rw Ch 5-5, rw R 5+p prev r, 5+ next outer point of rr, 5-5, clr, rw Repeat from * around, joining large rings to next point of rr and ending last ch by joining into base of 1st r. End off and hide ends.
