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The reason for the names are that [Mark Myers](#) challenged me in May 2009 to make a goat!!! The old goat (old git or nanny goat) is simply named after myself!!!

Both goats are worked in one pass with just one cut and tie at the end. To make a nanny goat leave out the horns and the 'beard'. Instructions are given.

Materials required:- 2 shuttles and size 20 thread in the same colour on each shuttle. Add 2 beads to shuttle 2

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

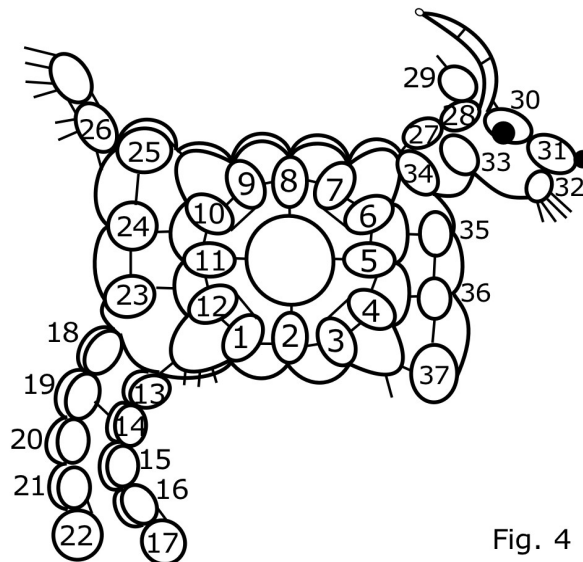
