The llama measures approximately 4" in length by 3½" in height when worked with a size 20 thread.

Skills required:- A knowledge of split rings and self closing mock ring.

Materials required:- 2 shuttles, size 20 thread and one size 9 (approximately) bead. Wind the two shuttles CTM with 6¼ yards on shuttle 1 and 5 yards on shuttle 2.

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tating the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

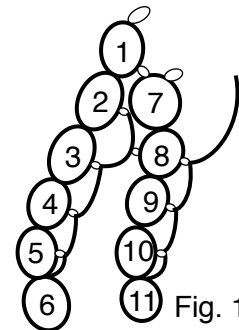

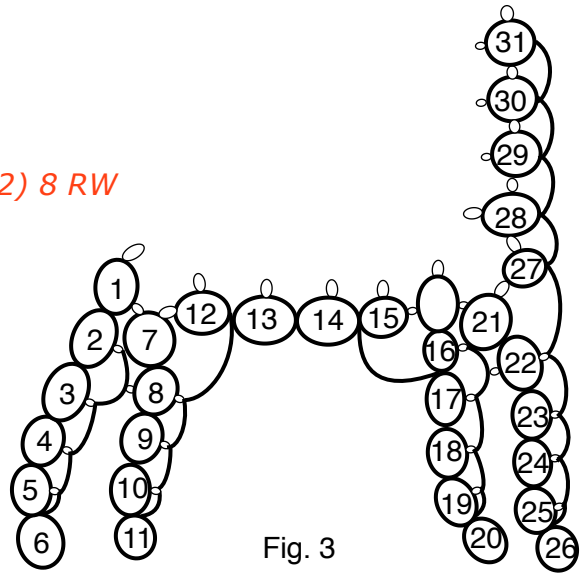

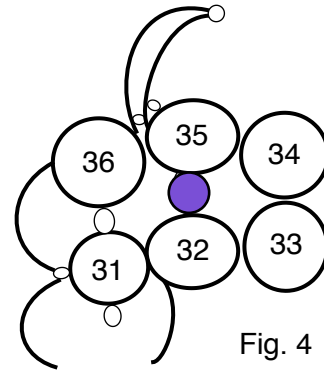

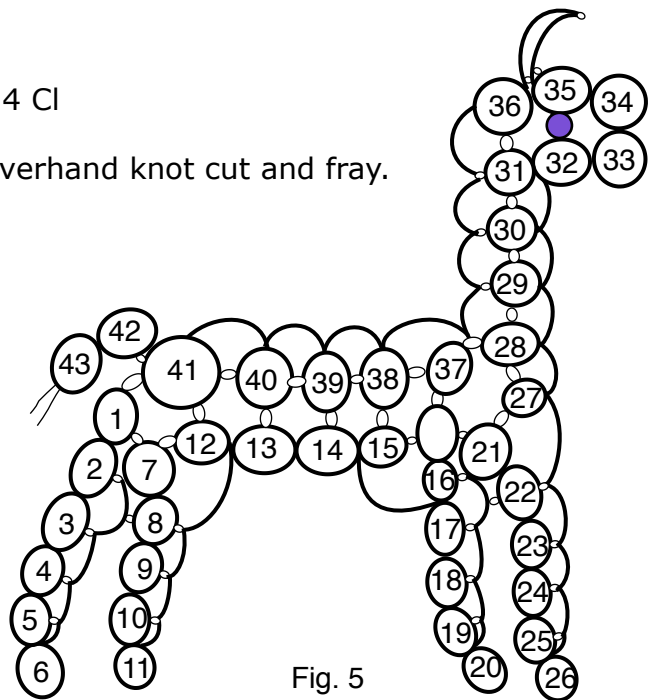


Fig. 5

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
