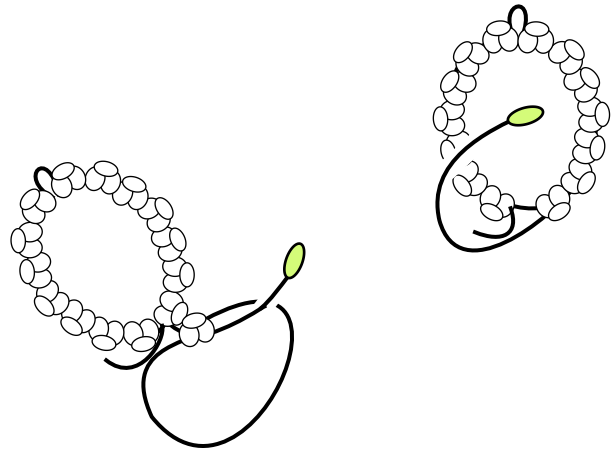


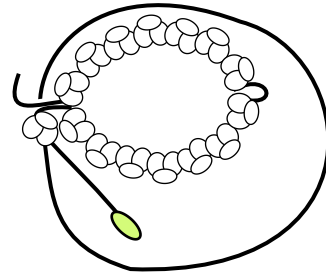
Making a Single Shuttle Onion Ring © Judith Connors & Jane Eborall 2020

Make a ring with a small picot and post the shuttle through the ring before closing.

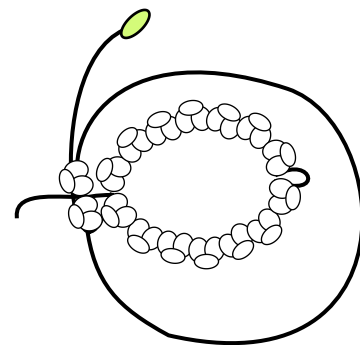
Make 1 ds by the base of the ring just made.



ROTATE the small ring 180° so that it lies in the centre of the new ring being made. This passes OVER the new ring thread running round the back of the hand.



Take the shuttle thread OVER the small ring and tat a second double which will encapsulate the small ring thread between the two new double stitches.



Continue tatting the outer ring according to the pattern using the slope and roll join to anchor to the small picot on the inner ring.

Close the outer ring carefully to fit neatly round the inner ring.
