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This pattern is worked from start to finish without having to tie and cut at the end. Finished size in No. 20 approximately 3" long.

**Skills Required:** A knowledge of Split Rings and adding beads.

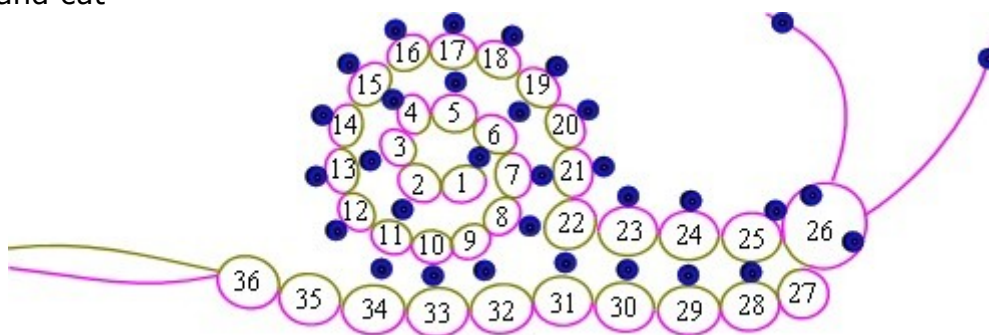
