This pattern is worked from start to finish without having to tie and cut until the end. Finished size in No. 20 approximately 3" long.

## **Abbreviations**

SR Sh1 shuttle 1 ring split ring Sh2 shuttle 2 RW reverse work CI close T & Ctie and cut В bead

VIp very long picot MB move bead on core thread vsp very small picot

move bead to back of hand before starting this ring MBBH

Materials required: size 20 thread in two contrasting colours, two shuttles and two size 10 or 11 seed beads.

Wind 2¾ yards on Sh1 and 1¾ yards on Sh2. Before starting add 2 eye beads to Sh1. Use Sh1 throughout - starting in the centre.

SR26: MBBH (2 beads) 2 + (SR25) 3 make a Vlp (1") and include one bead in that picot. Make 1 double. Now twist the picot clockwise about 8 times keeping the bead in the centre of the twist. Next join back to the work 2 VIp as the last one twisting and joining picot as before 6 / 3 CI

SR27: 6 / 3 Cl

SR28: 6 / 3 + (SR25) 3 Cl

SR29: 6 / 3 + (SR24) 3 Cl

SR30: 6 / 3 + (SR23) 3 Cl

SR31:6/3+(SR22)3Cl

SR32: 6 / 3 + (SR9) 3 Cl

SR33: 6 / 3 + (SR10) 3 Cl

SR34: 6 / 3 + (SR11) 3 Cl

SR35: 6 / 6 Cl

SR36: 6 / 6 Cl T & C leaving thread ends
