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### Materials required

No. 20 Crochet cotton, 1 shuttle, small beads, small plastic (or brass) ½" ring. (I used plastic Austrian/festoon blind rings which measure ½" in diameter and cost VERY little!)

### Abbreviations

B	bead (on chain or shuttle thread) to replace picot	+B	join with bead added to previous p
RG	plastic/brass ring	T & C	tie and cut
<sup>BBB</sup> <sub>B</sub>	3 beads on chain thread & one on shuttle thread all moved into position. (see fig. 2)		

### Method

Add 6 beads to the shuttle thread & 42 beads to chain thread before starting. Also further beads are needed for adding to picots.

Start with clover of: -

R1: 3 - 3 - 3 - 3

\*R2: 3 +B(R1) 3 +(RG) 3 - 3

R3: 3 +B(R2) 3 - 3 - 3

Ch: 4 B 4

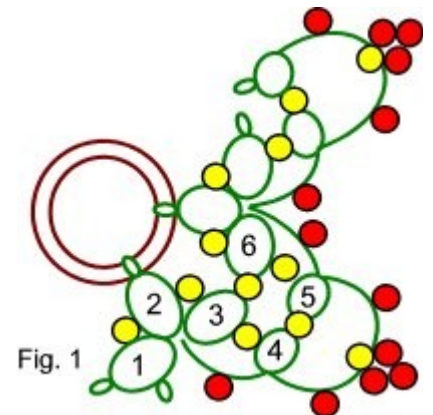
R4: 2 +B(R3) 2 - 2

Ch: 5 B 5 <sup>BBB</sup><sub>B</sub> 5 B5

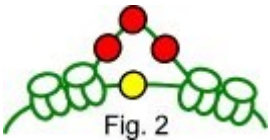
R5: 2 +B(R4) 2 - 2

Ch: 4 B 4

R6: 3 +B(last p R5) 3 +(2<sup>nd</sup> p R3) 3 - 3



Repeat from \* five times (6 points) joining 3<sup>rd</sup> ring of last clover to 2<sup>nd</sup> p of R1 and last R5 to 1<sup>st</sup> p of R1 T & C
