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**Materials required**

No. 20 Crochet cotton, 1 shuttle, small beads, small plastic (or brass) 1/2" ring. (I used plastic Austrian/festoon blind rings which measure 1/2" in diameter and cost VERY little!)

**Abbreviations**

- B bead (on chain or shuttle thread) to replace picot
- +B join with bead added to previous p
- RG plastic/brass ring
- T & C tie and cut
- <sup>BBB</sup><sub>B</sub> 3 beads are moved onto the back of the hand before starting the ring and the fourth bead is moved into place on the working thread beneath. (see fig. 2)

**Method**

To work snowflake - Place 50 beads on shuttle thread, and have more to add to picots.

- R1: 3 - 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 8 +(RG) 8
  - \*R2: 3 +B(R1) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 3 - 3
  - R3: 3 +B(R2) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 3 - 3 Clover of
  - R4: 3 +B(R3) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Move 3 beads onto back of hand before starting next R
  - R5: 3 +B(R4) 3 <sup>BBB</sup><sub>B</sub> 3 - 3
  - R6: 3 +B(R5) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 3 +B(last Ch) 3
  - R7: 3 +B(R6) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 3 +B(Ch btwn R2 & R3)) 3
  - R8: 3 +B(R7) 3 B 3 - 3
  - Ch: 8 +(RG) 8
- Repeat from \* four times joining last R8 to R1. T & C

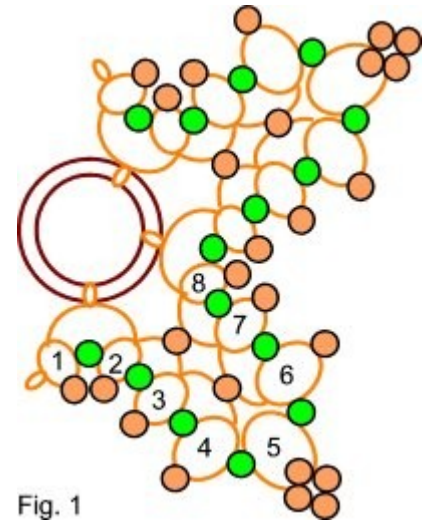

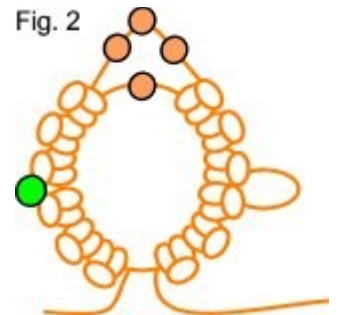
