

# Snowflake on Small Plastic or Brass Ring - worked with Overlapping points - © Jane Eborall

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## Materials needed

Four shuttles. No. 20 thread. 20 small beads on each Wsh2. Small plastic (or brass) 1/2" ring. I used plastic Austrian/festoon blind rings which measure 1/2" in diameter and cost approximately .05 of a penny each!! Not bad, eh?!! **N.B. Each PAIR of shuttles has a Wsh1 & a Wsh2**

## Abbreviations

RG	plastic/brass ring	- or p	picot	SR	split ring
+B	add bead to picot before joining	BBB <sub>B</sub>	3 beads from back of hand & 1 from shuttle	T & C	Tie and cut

Place 20 beads on each Wsh2 before starting

Use first pair of shuttles (green) & Wsh1 of this pair make

R1: 2 - 2 +(RG) 2 - 2

\*Ch: 8 Rw

R2: 2 - 2

Ch: 4

SR3: 3 - 3 / 6 Change to Wsh2

Move 3 beads to back of hand before starting next ring.

R4: 6 BBB<sub>B</sub> 6 Change to Wsh1

SR5: 3 +B(SR3) 3 / 6

Ch: 4

R6: 2 +B(R2) 2

Ch: 8

Drop the shuttles with green and use pair of shuttles with orange thread.

**N.B. In subsequent repeats bring the new pair of shuttles over the last point worked - See fig. 1**

Use Wsh1 of this pair make

R7: 2 +B(3rd p of R1) 2 +(RG) 2 - 2

Ch: 6

SR8: 3 - 3 / 6 Change to Wsh2

Move 3 beads to back of hand before starting next ring.

R9: 6 BBB<sub>B</sub> 6 Change to Wsh1

SR10: 3 +B(SR8) 3 / 6

Ch: 6 Leave these two shuttles and return to first pair bringing the chain over the last colour worked (see fig. 1) and continue using Wsh1 with

R11: 2 +B(R7) 2 +(RG) 2 - 2

Repeat from \* 4 times (10 points) joining the last orange centre ring to the first green centre ring. Be careful to always bring the new section over the top of the previously worked section. Join last chains of both colours to bases of corresponding first rings.

T & C both pairs of rings.

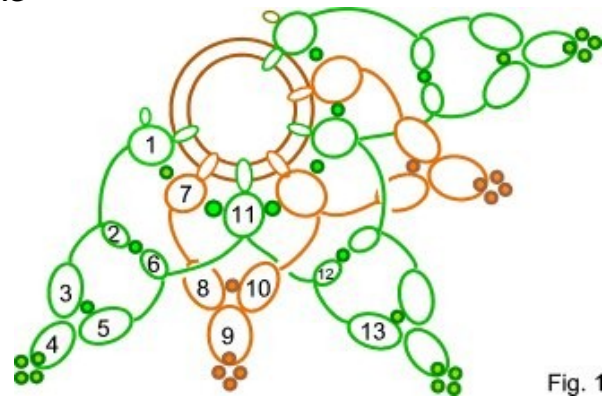
