## HOME Large Motif - Cabone Ring - © Jane Eborall 2003 Amended in 2019

A simple decoration measuring 2½" across and which needs no sewing in of ends.

**Materials:** No. 20 thread – two colours, 12 small beads, 1 (curtain ring) in plastic or brass and measuring 1" in diameter and two shuttles. Finished item measures 2" in diameter.

## **Abbreviations:**

Sh1 shuttle 1 Sh2 shuttle 2 CR Curtain (cabone) ring (plastic or brass)

T&C Tie and cut B bead MBBH move bead to back of hand

vsp very small picot SR Split Ring Cl close

**Note** – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

The snowflake is worked in two parts – the central part and then the outer.

**Centre -** 6 beads on Sh2. Suggestion when working the centre. Join the first four split rings to the CR as if joining to the outside then turn them to the centre and work the last two.

SR1: 4 + (CR) 4 / 2 B 2 CI

Repeat SR 5 more times T & C to start of SR1

Outer - 6 beads on Sh1. Do not join shuttle threads before starting SR1.

SR1: 4 + (CR - between joins) 4 / Leave 15" end before starting second half 2 vsp 8 Cl

\*SR2:4 + (CR - between same joins) 4 / 8 vsp 2 Cl RW SS

R3: MBBH 2 + (vsp on last SR) 8 B 8 vsp 2 Cl RW SS

SR4: 4 + (CR - between next centre joins) 4 / 2 + (vsp last R) 8 Cl

Repeat from \* 4 times

SR17: 4 + (CR) 4 / 8 vsp 2 Cl RW SS

SR18: 2 + (vsp on SR17) 8 / take end left at start

make 2 + (vsp on SR1) 8 Cl

Take short end of thread through remaining bead on Sh2.

T & C leaving ends to tie into a hanging loop.
