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This design requires two thicknesses of threads - no. 20 and no. 80. The instructions are for a motif with beads but these can be excluded. Measurement is $33 / 4$ " from point to point.

Note - for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the double stitch first.

## Materials required

No. 20 thread \& No. 80 thread. 42 size 11 seed beads in one colour \& 36 in another.
