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The snowman is made in three parts which are joined as work progresses. The scarf, walking stick and flowers are added as required. Knowledge of split rings is needed. <u>Updated snowman</u> <u>can be found here.</u>

## **Materials Required**

No. 20 thread in black, white and colours of choice, two shuttles, two black beads for the eyes and two for buttons. One orange bead (mouth).
