Oval Basket or Trug – Jane Eborall © 2005 Amended 2018



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Materials needed

No. 20 threads in beige/brown (soil – base and round 1), green (stalks – round 2), pink (flowers – also round 2) and blue for the sky (round 3). Yellow can be used for the handle. 56 size 11 seed beads are required for round 3 (suggest clear, sparkly to represent stars) and the handle. Two small four holed shirt buttons measuring $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the removable handle.

Note: for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

R12: 2 + (R11) 2 + (R1) 2 - 2 Cl RW

Ch: 3 - 3 - 3 RW

R13: 2 + (R12) 2 + (R1) 2 - 2 Cl RW

Ch: 3 – 3 RW

R14: 2 + (R13) 2 + (R1) 2 - 2 CI RW

Ch: 3 - 3 RW

R15: 2 + (R14) 2 + (SR2) 2 - 2 CI RW

Ch: 3 – 3 RW

R16: 2 + (R15) 2 + (SR3) 2 - 2 CI RW



Round 1 (side) - 2 shuttles (pink on Sh1, green on Sh2) using Sh1

SR1: 3 vsp 6 / 3 Cl R2: 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 CISR3: 6 vsp 3 / 3 CI RW

3 vsp 3 RW Ch:

*SR4: 3 + (last SR) 3 / Lj (p on base - following repeats will be next p on base) 3 Lj (next p on base) 3 Cl RW

Ch: 3 vsp 3 RW

R5: 3 + (last p R2 which is last ring worked) 3 - 3 Cl

R6: 3 - 3 - 3 CI RW 3 + (last Ch) 3 RWCh:

SR7: 3 vsp 3 / 3 Lj (same p on base as last SR was

joined to) 3 Cl RW

Ch: + (next p base) 3 vsp 3 RW

SR8: 3 + (last SR) 6 / 3 Cl

R9: $3 + (2^{nd} p R6 which is last ring worked) 3 - 3 - 3 Cl$

SR10: 6 vsp 3 / 3 Cl RW Ch: 3 + (last Ch) 3 RW

Repeat from * six times and then repeat from * to R6.

R6: 3 - 3 + (1st p R2) 3 Cl RW

3 + (last Ch) 3 RW

SR7: 3 + (vsp R1) 3 / 3 Lj (same p on base as last SR was joined to) 3 Cl RW

+ (next p base) 3 + (vsp on 1st Ch of round) 3 T & C to base of 1st R2 of round.

Round 3 (top edge, blue) – 2 shuttles – add 24 beads to Sh 1 (stars)

Bead at back of hand

R1: 2 + (any R2 round 2) 2 vsp 2 B 2 Cl

SR2: 2/2CI

Bead at back of hand

SR3: 2 B 2 / 2 + (next R5 round 2) 2 Cl

SR4: 2/2C

Bead at back of hand

SR5: 2 B 2 / 2 + (next R6 round 2) 2 Cl

SR6: 2/2CI

Repeat from SR3 all round the top joining final SR to R1 T & C

Handle – 2 shuttles. 32 beads are needed to add to picots. Side 1

3 + (hole in button) 3 - 3 - 3 Cl RW R1:

Ch: 6 RW

*R2: 3 + B (previous ring) 3 - 3 - 3 Cl RW

6 RW Ch:

Repeat from * 9 times

R12: 3 + B (previous ring) 3 - 3 + (hole in second button) 3 Cl T & C

Side 2

R13: 3 + (next hole in second button) 3 + B (R12) 3 - 3 Cl RW




*R14: 3 + B (previous ring) 3 + B (opposite R on side 1) 3 - 3 Cl RW

R24: 3 + B (previous ring) 3 + B (opposite R on side 1) 3 + (next hole on first button) 3 T & C To add to base take buttons through opposite spaces between rounds 2 and 3.
