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## Materials needed

No. 20 threads in beige/brown (soil - base and round 1), green (stalks - round 2), pink (flowers - also round 2) and blue for the sky (round 3). Yellow can be used for the handle. 56 size 11 seed beads are required for round 3 (suggest clear, sparkly to represent stars) and the handle. Two small four holed shirt buttons measuring $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for the removable handle.

Note: for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.
