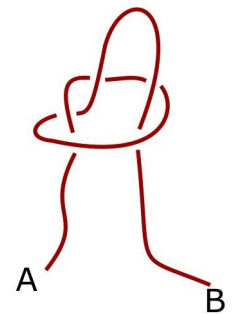


Making a Weaver's Knot

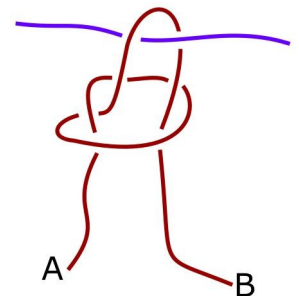
Why a weaver's knot?

Simply because it gives a slimmer knot than an overhand one and when made and is very strong. It's also very simple too.

First make a regular slip knot as in the drawing opposite.



Now take the second thread and put it through the loop you have just made.



Take hold of the original ends (A and B) and pull tightly away from each other. When you hear/feel the 'click' you will know the knot has been made.
