

„The Bookworm Collection“

Design by Anke Nienstedt, inspired by Jane Eborall's Bookworm

Abbreviations:

R = ring, SR = split ring, Ch = Chain, B = Bead,
rw = reverse work, T&C = tie and cut
- = small picot, — = long picot

Wind two shuttles with socks wool. Add two beads for the eyes on shuttle 1.

Berta and Bobby Bookworm

Leave the two beads on the shuttle thread until the pattern says "B". Then move the bead next to the last double knot before making the next knot.

R 3 B 8 B 2 - 1 rw
Ch 3 rw
SR 2 + 4 / 6
SR 6 / 3 - 3
SR 6 / 3 - 3
SR 4 / 8
SR 4 / 4



T&C, leave short ends

The picots at the bottom are for joining a tassel or a split ring row.

Walter the Woolly Worm

Leave the two beads on the shuttle thread until the pattern says "B". Then move the bead next to the last double knot before making the next knot.

R 4 B 1—1—1—1—1—1—1 B 3 - 1 rw
Ch 3 rw
SR 2 + 1—1—1—1—1 / 7
SR 1—1—1—1—1—1 / 3 - 4
SR 1—1—1—1—1—1—1 / 4 - 3
SR 1—1—1—1—1—1—1 / 7
SR 1—1—1—1 / 4
Ch 1—1—1



T&C, leave very short ends

Cut all picots on the upper side.

The picots at the bottom are for joining a tassel or a split ring row...

Suggestion for the split ring row:

R 4 + 4 + 4 (join to the two picots at the bottom of the worms)
SR 6 / 6 repeat to desired length, T&C
