## Abbreviations

Materials required. 2 shuttles, number 20 thread, number 11 seed beads.
Note: for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

Add 2 beads to each shuttle. Another 22 beads will be added to picots.
Starting with Sh1

## Body

R1: 8 vsp $4-4 \mathrm{Cl}$ RW
Ch: 4 LBP (7 Beads) 4 RW
SR2: $4 / 3+(L B P$ last Ch) 3 Cl RW
Ch: $4 L B P$ (3 $B^{\prime} s$ ) 4 RW B @ back of hand before starting next R
R3: $4+B(R 1) 4 \operatorname{vsp} 4$ B 4 Cl RW


Ch: $4+L B P$ (last Ch) 4 RW
SR4: 4 / 3 B 3 Cl RW
Ch: $8 \mathrm{vsp} 2 R W$
R5: 2 vsp 2 Cl RW
Ch: 2 + (vsp last Ch) 8 RW
SR6: 4 / 3 B 3 Cl RW
Ch: $\quad 4 L B P\left(3 B^{\prime} s\right) 4 R W B$ @ back of hand before starting next R
R7: 4 B 4 vsp $4-4 \mathrm{Cl}$ RW
Ch: $4+(L B P$ last Ch) 4 RW
SR8: 4 / 3 LBP (7 B's) 3 Cl RW
Ch: $4+(L B P$ SR8) $4 R W$
SR9: $4+B(R 7) 4 / 8 \mathrm{Cl}$ DNRW but turn work upside down - see fig. 2
SR10: $4+($ vsp R7) $6+(v s p R 5) 6+(R 3) 4+(R 1) 5$ vsp $1 / 5$ vsp 1 Cl
SR11:1 $+(\operatorname{vsp}$ SR10) $5 / 1+(v s p$ SR10) 5 Cl and tie an overhand knot. Cut leaving ends to form antennae.

## Tail - 2 shuttles with 2 beads on each.

Join both shuttles to vsp at base of body (between chains which lie after SR4 \& before SR6). You do not need to tie - just push both ends through the vsp from OPPOSITE directions and tat over tails. Make a lock chain to measure roughly 4".
Alternatively you could work an Easy Pearl Tatted chain (see link) instead finishing off as follows:-
Using Sh1 first:-
Move 1 bead to back of hand before starting.
R1: $\quad 2-2 \mathrm{~B} 2-2 \mathrm{Cl}$ bead at back of hand before starting next R
R2: $2+B$ ( $p$ on R1) $2 B 2-2 C l$ SS RW. Bead at back of hand
R3: $2+B\left(1^{\text {st }} p\right.$ on R1) 2 B $2-2 \mathrm{Cl}$. Bead at back of hand.
R4: $2+B(p$ on R3) 2 B $2-2 C l$ RW SS
SR5: $2+B$ (p on R2) $2 / 2+B$ (p on R4) $2 C l \&$ cut threads
Add a few more beads to tail and tie a knot. See fig. 4.


## Alternative Tail

Just before finishing the chain make ds as follows
1 picot, ds on first side
1 picot, ds on second side
Make butterfly as follows - using Sh on first side and make rings as follows

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R1: 1 + (p on Lch) 4-1-1-4-2 Cl
R2: 2 + (last p R1) 8-1-1-10 Cl RW SS
R3: 1 + (p on Lch) 4-1-1-4-2Cl
R4: 2 + (last p R3) 8-1-1-10 Cl SS
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SR5: $5 / 5 \mathrm{Cl}$ Tie an overhand knot with both ends and cut leaving feelers.
