## **HOME** Winsome Drop Earrings © Jane Eborall 2010



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Simple earrings

Earrings with long picots (version 2)

Materials required. Thread (roughly size 40), beads (seed beads size 11) and a small metal split ring. Also large beads to place in between the ring and split ring (any size).

## **Abbreviations**

Split ring rina SR


LBP Long beaded picot

Bead moved along core thread Bead moved along thread at back of hand

The beads are moved into position as shown below in fig. 1.

For joining to the metal ring I use the method which is shown in fig. 2. After the previous ds I use a normal join to the metal ring, then move along a bead on the core shuttle thread. Another half ds is then worked followed by another join to the metal ring. Then continue with the pattern.








Fig. 2 Joins

## **Version 1 –** 1 yard of number 40 thread for each earring

For first ring put 21 beads on Sh1 leave an end of ¼ yard for 2<sup>nd</sup> shuttle. See fig. 3





10 beads @ back of hand

 $1~^{\text{B}}_{\text{B}}1~^{\text{B}}_{\text$ R1: 1 Cl

Take both threads through 1 small, 1 large and 1 small beads.


For SR put 15 beads on Sh1 & 5 on Sh2. Move 10 beads to back of hand before starting.

SR2:  $1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1$  /  $1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{C}$ l. Take both threads through 1 small, 1 large and 2/3 small beads. T & C

## **Version 2 – with long picots – 2<sup>nd</sup> version –** 1 yard thread for each earring.

For help with the long beaded picot (LBP) please see this page.

For first ring put 19 beads on Sh1 leave end of ¼ yard for 2<sup>nd</sup> shuttle.



8 beads @ back of hand

R1:  $1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1$  LBP (14)  $_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1$  + (metal split ring)  $_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1$  LBP (14)  $_{B}1^{B}_{B}1^{B}_{B}1$  Cl Take both threads through a small bead, large bead and another small one. Take each thread through the loop at the end of the closest LBP. Add a further small bead to EACH thread before starting next SR.

For SR put 12 beads on Sh1 & 4 on Sh2

8 beads @ back of hand

Take both threads through 1 small, 1 large and 2/3 small beads. T & C

I have varied the 'look' of very long picots by making them in different places on the ring. See the following for 'inspiration'.
