Materials required - 2 shuttles, number 20 thread, small seed beads and 10 safety pins or paperclips.

## Making the beaded SR's.

Work $1^{\text {st }}$ half of SR to the LBP


Add given quantity of beads to the core thread placing a pin at the end to hold - see fig. b

Snug up close to last ds worked and complete first half of SR.
Work second half of SR to the LBP

Now add the required number of beads to the thread ON SHUTTLE 2 and hold in place with a pin.

Snug up close to last ds worked and complete second half of SR as usual.


## Large leaf

Two shuttles with 5 beads on Sh1. Start first SR leaving ends of about 4"
